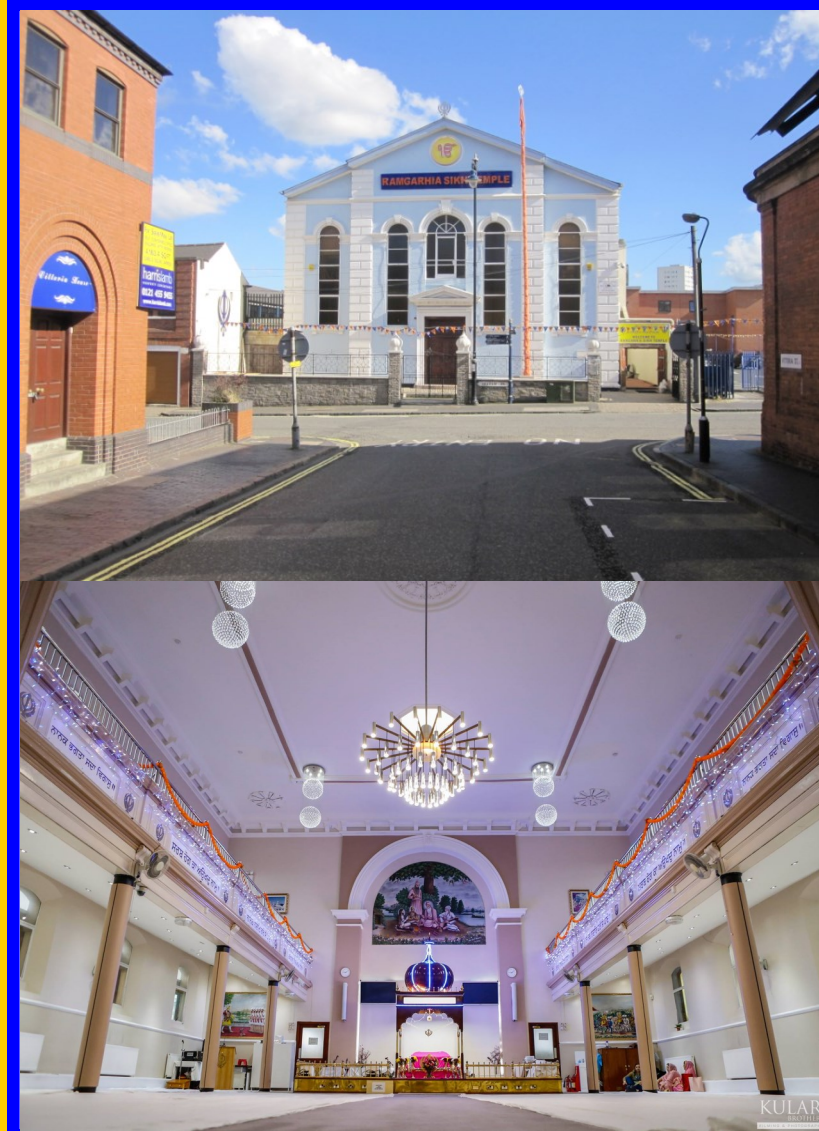

The new Management Committee was announced on the 20th May 2024 and with Waheguruji's 'mehar' and everyone's cooperation there were no Elections and all resolved on a compromise basis. This was the same for the Property Trustees and for the first time in the history of the Gurdwara avoiding expenditure, stress, and animosity which this normally brings. We thank all the candidates, their supporters, especially the Election Board members for their valuable contribution.

The Management Committee members will serve from May 2024 to May 2027, and the property Trustees from January 2024– September 2029.

Langar

Dear Sangat ji, many people have requested that we have one langar on days that we have multiple programs. The committee has approved this request, and we work with the sangat who make bookings and hopefully get full cooperation. Not only does this reduce the wastage that we get but also saves time and effort for the preparation of the langar.

We have also introduced a strict policy, **that langar must not be taken from the Gurdwara Sahib unless it is at the end of the day** and that the Gurdwara and Committee have no liability when it is taken with permission at your own risk. Please note that Sangat members should not request or put the sevadars in a difficult position by asking and a refusal may cause embarrassment. Mr Gurpreet Singh Chana and other volunteers who go above and beyond to support the Gurdwara functions in preparing and serving the langar which is time consuming,

Ramgarhia Community Centre (RCC)

New round tables and chivari chairs have been purchased for Ramgarhia Community Centre offering the members and sangat who hire it a better facility. We will continue making additional. The Hall is being used for Wedding tea and milni and more recently for lunch, when numbers were difficult to accommodate in the langar hall. We have the facility of the Gym on the 1st floor in RCC and Badminton sessions on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursdays

Education – “Vidya vichari tan Paropkari”

Sadh Sanagt Ji education is important for our youngsters and adults and even more important is learning the Punjabi language. This will allow our community to read and comprehend Gurbani and enable them to understand the value of Sikh culture and how to keep and protect their identity. The Committee are doing their utmost to promote our mother tongue (Punjabi language) and run Punjabi classes at infants, junior and A level standards. We urge all families to speak Punjabi at home to help our youngsters with the Punjabi language.

RST are proud to continue offering our Punjabi and music classes, providing a strong foundation in both language and the arts for students of all ages. This year, our students achieved outstanding results, with many earning high grades in their A-level and GCSE exams. We wholeheartedly congratulate each of our students on their hard work and success, as well as their parents, whose support has been invaluable throughout the learning journey.

IGOLAK

Dear Members and Sadh Sangat ji, The Gurdwara will be installing two Digital Golaks prior to Guru Nanak dev Ji's Gurburb. This will enable members to use their credit cards to make donations and either print you a receipt, email it or receive a text message. Many other Gurdwaras have benefitted from this as it automates and secures all payments. Sangat Members with the receipt can use that to perform their 'mata tek'. This is a key advancement in ensuring full auditing controls and transparency. The traditional receipt books will also be used for those sangat members who prefer to pay by cash.

RST Litigation Claim

Dear Sadh Sangat Ji we wish to be transparent and inform you that the litigation claim which was bought against the gurdwara sahib and the Gurdwara and Committee was successfully defended and the Gurdwara won the case. Some members choose to advise and misguide the sangat incorrectly but a copy of the order can be obtained from the RST offices at any time.

Harcharan Singh Bahra, Kulwant Singh Rehal and Manmohan Singh Sagoo who bought the claim against the Gurdwara are fully aware that they were unsuccessful.

The costs for both parties was ordered by the Judge to be paid by the Gurdwara despite the Gurdwara winning the case. The reason for this is that, members of the Gurdwara who are given permission to take the case to court have to be paid by the Gurdwara despite the defendants losing. The Charity Commission did not give the defendants the permission to take this to court however in reading the statement which allowed them caused doubt for the judge which proved to be incorrect in the end.

Their solicitor has failed to provide a breakdown of the costs which our RST Solicitor has questioned, and still after 18 months their solicitor is refusing to provide a detailed breakdown.

The costs would not have been incurred by the Gurdwara in the first place had they not bought their 'unsuccessful' claim so we need to do justice for the Gurdwara Sahib in questioning the bill which equated to approximately £26k. Once this matter is concluded the Committee will update the members, however all paperwork and evidence can be seen in the RST office if required.

Main Diwan Hall Ceiling

Dear members due to the adverse weather conditions this autumn and the heavy rainfall in the main roof caused a part of ceiling to fall. This was overnight and with Waheguruji kirpa no one was hurt. The committee had no option until this was made safe again to close down the hall and utilise the Diwan hall in the Education centre.

Repairs will be undertaken asap and the main Diwan hall is fully safe and operational again.

The committee have taken a decision to replace the complete roof on that side which is aged and is being treated as emergency repairs. Hopefully this investment will ensure safety and better aesthetics for the sangat moving forward.

Istri Sabha

We are thankful to the Istri Sabha committee (for their continued support, hard work and sewa for the community. The Istri Sabha hold the weekly Satsang every Thursday between 12-2pm. The Istri Sabha is also very active in helping with the preparation of the langar and cleaning and they also have successfully arranged visits to the seaside and Blackpool this year. Everyone is welcome to join the congregations every Thursday where langar is served.

Over 60's Men's classes

Dear Sadh Sangat Ji an Over 60's initiative was setup approximately 18 months ago. It has grown from about 5 participants to over 30 and held every Thursday at Ramgarhia Community Centre between 12 and 2 pm.

There are light exercise classes, seminars on health and well being and seaside trips that have been successful.

If anyone is interested in attending please attend on the day and you will be most welcome.

Filming at RST

Dear Sadh sangat we are proud to advise you that the Gurdwara with its prime location and excellent ambience of the main diwan hall has been used by several companies for filming television serials. This generates income from the car park and hiring of the hall for the Gurdwara sahib and gives us excellent coverage. One of the programmes was 'DI Ray' which starred the actress Parminder Nagar.

Enhancing Programmes for the Sangat

The committee are delighted to advise you that with the co-operation of the sangat and especially the younger generation namely My Bobby Ubhi, Mr Sukh Matharu, Mr Gurpreet Singh Chana and Mr Inderpal Singh Lotay, we hosted some top Kirtani Jathae. We also had the privilege of hosting Harshdeep Kaur this summer which resulted in over 700 sangat members.

The Committee has made a commitment to provide funding regularly for these excellent artists preaching Gurbani. An Atam Ras Kirtan darbar has been held with three renowned jathas and, Bhai Davinder Singh Sodhi ji, Bhai Gurinder Singh Batala Wale ji, Bhai Maninder Singh Darbar Sahib Wale Ji, Bhai Harcharan Singh Khalsa ji, Bhai Jagtar Singh Jammu Wale ji, Bhai Jujhar Singh ji and Bhai Baljeet Singh USA Wale were a few to name, A summer Kirtan Diwan was also held with excellent Jathae and Basic of Sikhi, along with a health camp on the same day.

Granthi and Kirtan Jatha

Bhai Manjit Singh Ji Phagwara Wale and the Jatha are our serving Jatha on Tier 5 Visa's until April 2026. Bhai Harpreet Singh and Bhai Manjeet Singh are part of the Jatha. Giani Harsimran Singh is our resident Tier 2 Granthi and serving on a Tier 2 Minister of religion Visa.

Saving and preserving Sadh Sangat's Money and Assets

Sadh Sangat ji your committee is doing its utmost to save your money and find ways of delivering essential services to the congregation. It should be noted that this magazine is written, compiled, printed, bound and posted by your committee to save money and keep the congregation fully informed.

Solar Panels

These have been operative since March 2016.the Solar panels have generated electricity from both (main & education) systems of 230253kWh to date. There has been a Feed In Tariff income for the Gurdwara Sahib of approximately £50k since the install. Assuming similar savings in electricity bills we have saved the Sadh Sangat in excess of £80k. The system had paid for itself in 3.5 years. The remainder of this year and additional 12 year's of tariff payments would bring in huge amount of money.

Summer Demonstrations & Security

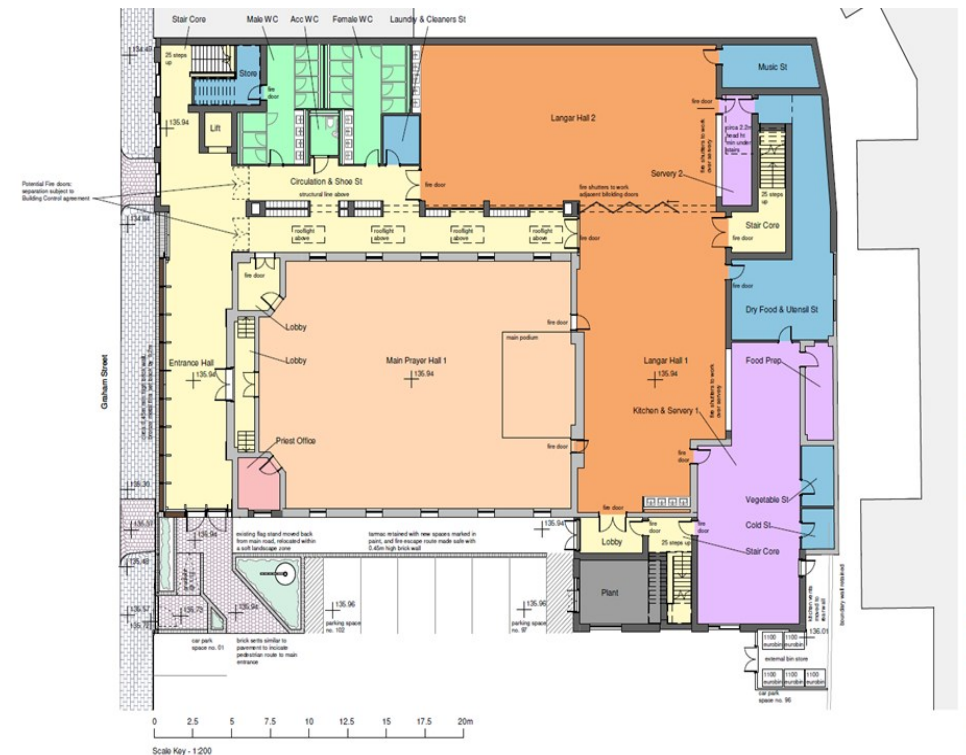
Dear Sadh Sangat Ji, the committee worked very closely with the Jewellery Quarter Commission and the Police to ensure the safety of the Gurdwara and sangat during this summers demonstrations and with Waheguruji's blessings and the correct action taken the demonstration was peaceful with no impact to the Gurdwara Sahib.

Mr Sukhninder Singh Bansal had already secured government security funding for new metal security doors, automated car park gates, ANPR System, Video Surveillance cameras and Alarm systems worth almost £200k in 2018 onwards. We are deeply thankful to him for his forward thinking.

Ramgarhia Jassa Singh Education Hall Development Update

Dear Sadh Sangat and members Ji, The Building Project has been progressing since the new committee has been appointed. The planning permission had been obtained in April 2023, however the three post holders were reluctant to start any work until the new committee was appointed which caused a delay of more than 12 months. Similar to delays during proceeding 24 months where external influences were preventing the Managing Committee to deliver this for the sangat.

There were many objections from the Jewellery Commission Heritage committee and it took a lot of persuading and justification where both Mr Harvinder Singh Nandhra and Mr Jaspal Singh Virdee instructed a planning consultant who had relationships with the council and as a combined effort the plans were approved, with small changes mainly to do with the external fascia which is shown below. This is essential however because we need to improve the traffic flow of sangat for public safety.

The committee has approved for building regulations to be quoted and these will then need to be assessed and approved. Our plan is to carry out the work in 3 Phases. Prior to any work all quotes will be approved in a General Body Meeting.

Phase 1—Existing Kitchen expansion, Giani accommodation renovation and expansion on 1st floor, heating and drainage upgrades, existing Langar Hall renovation, Plant room, cold storage room and upgrades to common areas.

Phase 2—Construction of new Langar Hall, Diwan Hall, Toilets and Offices and teaching floor on existing Ramgarhia Education Centre grounds as shown opposite.

Phase 3—New Fascia, lobby and front Entrance to the Gurdwara.



Programmes

Sadh Sangat Ji several programmes have been delivered since our last publication. These have been mainly Gurburbs, Weddings and Funerals.. All programmes can be booked from the RST Office On Tuesday and Friday evening between 7.00 to 8.30pm. Charges for events are to ensure that the Gurdwara breaks even on costs and not for profitability. The Gurdwara is a registered charity (506947), and a non profit making organisation. Any donations are gratefully accepted for the upkeep, running and cleaning costs

Marriage Bureau

The RST Marriage Bureau service is on-line and members are able to access the service with ease. The Marriage Bureau office is open on Tuesdays & Fridays evenings 19.00 to 20.30 and Sundays 12.00 to 13.00 where the members can ring or come to the office for help and information

We thank Mrs Satwant Kaur Galsinh, Mrs Narinder Kaur Bhogal and Mr Manjit Singh Bhogal for their voluntary seva in assisting the running of this. We also thank those families who have still been registering and using our services.

Gift-aid

Gift aid started in 2008 and last submission was in March 2021, but during covid 2019-2020 there had not been a submission. This was submitted December 2023 as we have 4 years to file these. Last years submission was approved where approx. £25k was given back in gift aid payments to RST. The Total received so far is approx. £320k. We would like to thank the Sadh Sangat for their kind donations and continued support. There is a lot of work in processing the Receipts and this work which was introduced by Mr Sukhninder Singh Bansal was a very valued initiative. Although this is time consuming for the volunteers, the rewards have been benefitting to RST and the Sangat.

RST Car Park

Dear sadh sangat ji. The gurdwara operates the car park for RST income generation. During weekdays the first 1 hour is free for the sangat to attend the gurdwara. If a longer time is required because langar is being prepared then you must inform the granthis who have the ability to extend this to 4 hours. On Funeral's weekends, wedding and other weekday programmes the RST Committee suspend the payments for the day. The Car park management is run by an external company and if tickets are issued it still costs the gurdwara approx. £15 to get these cancelled.
